Liability:

To be insured is the participant's own responsibility. The organizer and the Federation are excluded from any form of liability whatsoever. With the registration, the participant and the dojo-director confirm the physical and psychic health of the participant.

Equipment:

White Karate Gi (a club badge on the left chest is allowed). Bandages must be authorized by the Referees Committee. Contact lenses at your own risk. Glasses, jewellery, metal objects, headgear, etc. are not allowed in all categories.

Compulsory for Kumite:

Fist protectors white - type ESKA (maximum 3 cm thick) - **Gum shield**

Permitted for Kumite:

Groin guards, chest protector for female

Rules and System: ESKA and Swiss Ippon Shobu Rules

Double starts are allowed as follows:

- *Youths 14/15 years old can participate in Cadet Kata categories (but not in Kumite)*
- *Cadets 16/17 years old can participate in Junior Kata and Kumite categories.*
- *Juniors 18,19,20 years old can participate in Senior Kata and Kumite categories.*

International Senior Kumite Categories

For senior athletes with international experience, (who have already started at ESKA-WSKA or similar tournaments). Senior athletes can decide in which category they want to compete.

Note: Athletes, who start in the international categories are not allowed to start in other single Kumite categories! Exception: Seniors Team Kumite, a participation is possible in this category!
